## MEETING NOTICE

Next CRCA meeting is Monday, May 14, 2012, 7:00-9:00 PM

North Chevy Chase Elementary School (All Purpose Room)

CRCA is hosting a meeting with the Maryland Transit Administration to discuss the latest Purple Line plans. Our meeting will focus on the segment of the Purple Line that will run through our community on the Capital Crescent Trail. **This is our community's opportunity to provide input on the design and to learn about how it will impact our community.** We will be discussing hours of operation, noise levels, trail access ramps, design, train speeds, and other safety issues. Of particular concern is the current plans call for much of the rail line and trail to be on an elevated concrete platform between Jones Mill Road and Connecticut Avenue. There also are concerns over what impact the Lyttonsville rail yard facility will have on residents near the park. Our input will be crucial in determining the appearance of the Purple Line and in mitigating its impact on our community.

State Senator Rich Madeleno and Delegates Al Carr and Jeff Waldstreicher will be in attendance. This is a meeting NOT TO MISS!
